It won't be long until callers to the University Village Complex will be transferred directly to the campus voice mail system when residents are on-line. This feature helps alleviate the loss of telephone connection experienced when UVC residents use their computers to access on-line services.

Time to Re-Key the Complex

On Tuesday March 12, all apartments in the University Village Complex will be re-keyed. New apartment keys will be delivered to residents through the current mail system the week of March 4. The system will be set up very much as before, each apartment keyed separately, the apartment keys operating the corresponding storage closet, community centers and fence gate at US33. Residents will need to use the intercom/entry system at the main entrances as before; we will not have apartment key access at these locations. This is the first complete re-keying of apartment units since the mid 1980's. In conjunction with the new Door King entry system this project will greatly enhance security.
