The University Village's request to receive University supplied laundry machines has been granted. However, University Village plumbing must meet specific requirements to handle large capacity washing machines. We are grateful that the University has also agreed to renovate the plumbing in preparation for the new machines. This project is currently underway. All apartments will receive new laundry plumbing but, only 40 apartments will receive new machines this year. *The machines are not coin operated.* The entire installation project is expected to take two-three years.

Safety First

In a continuing effort to provide safe housing for student families of Notre Dame, the University of Notre Dame Fire Department and McDaniel Fire Systems are working together to install a sprinkler system into all buildings of University Village and Cripe Street Apartments including the Beichner Community Center. This project should last all summer. All holes will be filled and pipes will be painted.
