On home football Saturdays the University Village Complex operates under special traffic provisions. Douglas Road and the entrance to University Village are closed off approximately three and half hours before kick-off. Our main entrance reopens up to two hour after the game. Bikes and strollers are out in force on University Drive as we begin another great year in our community. Please store these items safely either on the cement downspouts next to the buildings or on the bike racks. Unsafe zones for storage include: sidewalks, grass, front porches, building entrances and common corridors. Please think of others as you store your items safely.

## Completing the System

The final stage for the completion of the new University Village and Cripe St. Apartments Fire Alarm Systems has begun. Crews from Thompson Electrical will be working over the next few weeks in the halls of all buildings, selected storage closets and all apartment units. Please expect some noise and dust. The workers are willing to work with your family schedules. Please communicate with them when they arrive at your door. Individual apartments can be completed in three hours or so. Electric wiring is mounted to the

ceiling and connected to a detector that sends a message to the Notre Dame Fire Department when an individual sprinkler head is activated. In this way the Fire Department knows exactly which building has an activated sprinkler head. This cuts their response time down by a tremendous amount. Having the new Fire Alarm System is a significantly improved safety feature for our community.
