## Ready for Kick-Off

During all home football games Douglas Road and the main entrance to University Village will be closed off approximately *three and a half hours before kick-off*. ## The Arrival of ResNet

The Office of Telecommunications and OIT will begin the installation of new telephone lines and fiber optic cables in the University Village Apartments beginning Monday, September 8. The technicians will be arriving at individual apartments beginning at 8:00 am. Work should be completed each day by 2:00 pm and phone lines will be up and running again by 4:00 each afternoon. *Please be sure to clear your own phone wall plate of desks, bags or items that block the work area.* The current single wall plates will be replaced with double port plates. Blue will activate the phone and Gold will activate the data port.

Preparation can begin now so that all are ready to plug in. All home computers will need to have a NIC (network interface card). Pour used motor oil in a disposable milk container

and put it by the garage door of the white maintenance shed located near the entrance of the University Village. As a service to residents, maintenance staff will dispose of it properly. Do not leave rags, filters, bottles, antifreeze or paint thinners at the maintenance shed or beside a dumpster.

Motor vehicles *may not* be washed or waxed on the grass or on the streets in front of the buildings. The areas adjacent to the fire hydrants where sufficient water outlets are provided are the ideal location for washing cars.
